## The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

## Notice of adoption of the North West Secmaton Lane (DA2) and Dawlish Green Infrastructure (DA6), Dawlish Development Framework Plan Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

In accordance with Regulations 11, 14 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is given that Teignbridge District Council adopted its DA2 and DA6 Dawlish Development Framework Plan Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2016.

Under Section 23(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 the Council has modified the SPD to take account of representations made in relation to the document (which are set out in the statement of public participation), and any other relevant matters.

## North West Secmaton Lane (DA2) and Dawlish Green Infrastructure (DA6), Dawlish Development Framework Plan Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

The purpose of the SPD will be to guide planning applications and decisions, towards the successful implementation of Policies DA2 and DA6 in the adopted Teignbridge Local Plan. It will ensure that a comprehensive approach is taken, in light of individual planning applications being made for parts of the allocation, and that infrastructure will be delivered to support the development.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted (21<sup>st</sup> June 2016).
